Aviv's theme is "The Journey Begins"

How does Aviv's "The Journey Begins" connect to the last year's New Life themes?

Month 10 - Tevet taught me "New Life Decisions" must be the source of "New Journeys"

Month 11 - Shevat taught me "New Journeys" require I have "New Discernments"

Month 12 - Adar taught me "New Discernments" demand I "Sanctify My Journey"

Where does understanding "The Journey Begins" begin this month?

With realizing Sanctifying my Journey yields to a submission to Adonai as my Redeemer [goel]

What should I realize about the Hebrew [goel] aka "one of my close relatives?"

Technically, it is "a relative who comes to your _____"

Thus, a [goel] is not just your redeemer; he is your deliverer as well

What 3 specific praise-worthy rights did the Redeemer/Deliverer possess? - He could

_____ back a relative's forfeited inheritance who sold his land due to poverty

As Boaz did for Naomi (Ruth 4:3-5)

_____ his kinsman in bondage to a foreigner

Lev 25:47-48 "If a foreigner living with you has grown rich, and a member of your people has become poor and sells himself to this foreigner living with you or to a member of the foreigner's family, 48 he may be redeemed after he has been sold. One of his brothers may redeem him" CJB

_____ the death of a slain kinsman as a point of honor

Num 35:20-21 "Likewise, if he shoves him out of hatred; or intentionally throws something at him, causing his death; 21 or out of hostility strikes him with his hand, so that he dies; then the one who struck him must be put to death; he is a murderer; and the next-of-kin avenger is to put the murderer to death upon meeting him." CJB

How does this apply to me this year? - On this journey my Adonai wants to ...

Work some things out IN me before He restores some things TO me

Heb 2:14-15 "Therefore, since the children share a common physical nature as human beings, he became like them and shared that same human nature; so that by his death he might render ineffective the one who had power over death (that is, the Adversary) 15 and thus set free those who had been in bondage all their lives because of their fear of death."

Where does understanding “The Journey Begins” continue?

With realizing my Redeemer/Deliverer’s Plan this year involves a specific ministry to

_____ men for the ending of Gentile conversion & beginning of Israelite conversion

Why? - Natural Israel needs their heart veil removed to prepare for Yeshua’s arrival

2 Cor 3:15-16 “Yes, till today, whenever Moshe is read, a veil lies over their heart. 16 “But,” says the Torah, “whenever someone turns to Adonai, the veil is taken away.” CJB

And the Redeemer/Deliverer will do this during the season of the 144,000 witnesses

Rev 7:2-4 “I saw another angel coming up from the east with a seal from the living God, and he shouted to the four angels who had been given power to harm the land and the sea, 3 “Do not harm the land or the sea or the trees until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads!” 4 I heard how many were sealed – 144,000 from every tribe of the people of Isra’el” CJB

Note the 144,000 are not martyrs, but the seal implies they have divine protection

How does this apply to me this year? - On this journey my Adonai wants me to ...

_____ untaught Christians the Anti-Messiah arrives before Yeshua

_____ in budding Remnant Christian’s becoming Messianic Sheep

_____ me to be aware of His spiritual (not natural) Torah framework as a Messianic

James 1:25 “But if a person looks closely into the perfect Torah, which gives freedom, and continues, becoming not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work it requires, then he will be blessed in what he does.” CJB.”

How does this apply to me this year? - On this journey my Adonai wants me to ...

Boldly live the precepts of His spiritual Torah before all men, especially Christians

_____ His presence, behold the glory of His face, and permanently be changed

2 Cor 3:18 “So all of us, with faces unveiled, see as in a mirror the glory of the Lord; and we are being changed into his very image, from one degree of glory to the next, by Adonai the Spirit.”

Note - Moshe did not always wear the veil; he took it off when he spoke to Yahweh

Ex 34:32-35 “Afterwards, all the people of Isra’el came near; and he passed on to them all the orders that Adonai had told him on Mount Sinai. 33 Once Moshe had finished speaking with them, he put a veil on his face. 34 But when he went in before Adonai for him to speak, he would take the veil off until he came out; then, when he came out, he would tell the people of Isra’el what he had been ordered.” CJB

How does this apply to me this year? - On this journey my Adonai wants me to ...

Remove my fleshly soul veil and meet Him face to face to deal with the real me

Where does understanding “The Journey Begins” end this month?

With rejoicing in the fulfillment of my Redeemer/Deliverer’s Promises along with way

Jer 16:21 “Therefore, I will make them know, once and for all, I will make them know my power and my might. Then they will know that my name is Adonai (Yahweh).” CJB

How does this apply to me this year? - On this journey my Adonai wants me to ...

Cooperate with Him as He _____ and completes His good work in me

Phil 1:6 “And I am sure of this: that the One who began a good work among you will keep it growing until it is completed on the Day of the Messiah Yeshua” CJB

What should I already know about the 1st month of Aviv?

Is a month of notable deaths & events - Aaron’s 2 sons (1st), Miriam (10th), and Joshua (26th)

Noah’s Ark rested on Mt. Ararat and the Ark was put in wilderness tent for 1st time this month

Israel eats in the PL for 1st time & Ezra keeps Pesach in PL for 1st time after captivity this month

Is a month linked with Y’hudah (Jacob’s 4th son by Leah) & foreshadows Yeshua

What does the Father want me to remember about this 1st month of Aviv?

Aviv is not properly a name of a month, but a phrase noting “the month of young ears of barley”

This month wasn’t called Nisan until after the Captivity (Neh 2:1)

Difference in focus - Nisan focuses on God’s miracles, Aviv focuses on barley _____

Because barley grows wild like a weed, Yahweh ensured men always have food

Y’hudah’s tribe is linked to praise (esp. violent praise) particularly in regards to deliverance

2 Sam 6:14-15 “Then David danced and spun around with abandon before Adonai, wearing a linen ritual vest. 15 So David and all the house of Isra’el brought up the ark of Adonai with shouting and the sound of the shofar.” CJB

How does this apply to me this year? - On this journey my Adonai wants me to ...

Abandon old ways of praising Him in favor of more grateful expressions

Why? - Y’hudah’s name means to _____

What new perspectives does the Father want me to have about this 1st month of Aviv?

Aviv is not just a month of redemption - It is an appointed time for me to

_____ in His month of miracles & know He will set me on the right course for my future

_____ forth in spiritual strength and walk on the path the Spirit presents to me this year

Y’hudah is not just a tribe of royalty - It is a tribe of conquerors

Y’hudah prevailed because they had the most men who would go to war 1st

Y’hudah also prevailed because they had the most men who would openly worship Yahweh

Notes

What new truths does my Father want me to embrace about the 1st month of Aviv?

It is my appointed time to prevail over long term distressing circumstances & personal oppressors

I'm grateful I'm alive to conquer again in Aviv because I'm grateful to have "survived" Adar

I'm grateful to delight in this year's fruit because I "survived" last year's [Man] (manna)

Conclusion

Aviv is my appointed time to be supernaturally reset, redeemed and released

But my Adonai needs to deliver me from some inner Pharaohs first to fully accomplish this

And He will deliver me from some of them in _____ fashion

Isa 43:2 "When you pass through water, I will be with you; when you pass through rivers, they will not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire, you will not be scorched – the flame will not burn you." CJB

Y'hudah is my appointed example, as the worshipper conqueror

Like them, I may lose some battles along the way; I will never slack off or quit

2 Chron 15:7 "But you, be strong, and don't slack off; for your work will be rewarded." CJB
