## Responsive Scripture Reading



Then Moshe called for all the leaders of Isra'el and said, "Select and take lambs for your families, and slaughter the Pesach lamb. Take a bunch of hyssop leaves and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and smear it on the two sides and top of the door-frame.

**Cong** Then, none of you is to go out the door of his house until morning.

For Adonai will pass through to kill the Egyptians; but when he sees the blood on the top and on the two sides, Adonai will pass over the door and will not allow the Slaughterer to enter your houses and kill you.

**Cong** You are to observe this as a law, you and your descendants forever.

"When you come to the land which Adonai will give you, as he has promised, you are to observe this ceremony.

**Cong** When your children ask you What do you mean by this ceremony?'

Say, 'It is the sacrifice of Adonai's Pesach [Passover], because [Adonai] passed over the houses of the people of Isra'el in Egypt, when he killed the Egyptians but spared our houses.'"

**Cong** The people of Isra'el bowed their heads and worshipped. Then the people of Isra'el went and did as Adonai had ordered Moshe and Aharon — that is what they did.

At midnight Adonai killed all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh sitting on his throne to the firstborn of the prisoner in the dungeon, and all the firstborn of livestock.

**Cong** Pharaoh got up in the night, he, all his servants and all the Egyptians; and there was horrendous wailing in Egypt; for there wasn't a single house without someone dead in it.

He summoned Moshe and Aharon by night and said, "Up and leave my people, both you and the people of Isra'el; and go, serve Adonai as you said.

**Cong** Take both your flocks and your herds, as you said; and get out of here! But bless me, too."

## Psalm 113

Halleluyah! Servants of Adonai, give praise! Give praise to the name of Adonai! Blessed be the name of Adonai from this moment on and forever! From sunrise until sunset Adonai's name is to be praised. Adonai is high above all nations, his glory above the heavens. Who is like Adonai our God, seated in the heights, humbling himself to look on heaven and on earth.

He raises the poor from the dust, lifts the needy from the rubbish heap, in order to give him a place among princes, among the princes of his people.

He causes the childless woman to live at home happily as a mother of children. Halleluyah!

## Psalm 114

When Isra'el came out of Egypt, the house of Ya'akov from a people of foreign speech, Y'hudah became [God's] sanctuary, Isra'el his domain.

The sea saw this and fled; the Yarden turned back; the mountains skipped like rams, the hills like young sheep.

Why is it, sea, that you flee? Why, Yarden, do you turn back? Why, mountains, do you skip like rams; and you hills like young sheep?

Tremble, earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Ya'akov, who turned the rock into a pool of water, flint into flowing spring.
