## Responsive Scripture Reading



This will be a day for you to remember and celebrate as a festival to Adonai; from generation to generation you are to celebrate it by a perpetual regulation.”

**Cong** “For seven days you are to eat matzah — on the first day remove the leaven from your houses. For whoever eats hametz [leavened bread] from the first to the seventh day is to be cut off from Isra’el.

On the first and seventh days, you are to have an assembly set aside for God. On these days no work is to be done, except what each must do to prepare his food; you may do only that.

**Cong** You are to observe the festival of matzah, for on this very day I brought your divisions out of the land of Egypt.

Therefore, you are to observe this day from generation to generation by a perpetual regulation. 18 From the evening of the fourteenth day of the first month until the evening of the twenty-first day, you are to eat matzah.

**Cong** During those seven days, no leaven is to be found in your houses.

Whoever eats food with hametz in it is to be cut off from the community of Isra’el — it doesn’t matter whether he is a foreigner or a citizen of the land

**Cong** Eat nothing with hametz in it. Wherever you live, eat matzah.”

Then Moshe called for all the leaders of Isra’el and said, “Select and take lambs for your families, and slaughter the Pesach lamb. 22 Take a bunch of hyssop leaves and dip it in the blood which is in the basin

**Cong** and smear it on the two sides and top of the door-frame. Then, none of you is to go out the door of his house until morning.

For Adonai will pass through to kill the Egyptians; but when he sees the blood on the top and on the two sides, Adonai will pass over the door and will not allow the Slaughterer to enter your houses and kill you.

**Cong** You are to observe this as a law, you and your descendants forever.

## Psalm 121

If I raise my eyes to the hills, from where will my help come? My help comes from Adonai, the maker of heaven and earth. He will not let your foot slip — your guardian is not asleep. No, the guardian of Isra’el never slumbers or sleeps.

Adonai is your guardian; at your right hand Adonai provides you with shade — the sun can’t strike you during the day or even the moon at night.

Adonai will guard you against all harm; he will guard your life. Adonai will guard your coming and going from now on and forever. CJB

## Psalm 122

I was glad when they said to me, “The house of Adonai! Let’s go!” Our feet were already standing at your gates, Yerushalayim. Yerushalayim, built as a city fostering friendship and unity.
