Important Details About This Map

1- It was originally shown to me in a dream in 1978

I was living in Cleveland Oh and had only been saved a little over a year

2- It involved Houston, but I had never been to Houston

I had never even thought about Houston; Gwen said come here, not Dallas

3- I was at a major life crossroad when I first saw it

I knew I was getting ready to make a move, I just didn't know where

4- I had a vision about it in prayer after a bible study

Details Of The Vision

1- I saw what I considered to be a bunch of church people worshipping in Houston

2- I thought it odd they weren't worshipping at a church, was a conference room

3- I thought it odd they weren't worshipping on Sunday, it was some other day

4- The message was very interesting, but something I never heard before

Fast Forward to May 2020

What Followed the Map & Vision Recall?

1- The Spirit brought a song to my mind the next day

It wasn't a totally new song to me. I had heard this song before

2- He impressed upon me to listen closely to the lyrics

When I listened carefully to the lyrics - I knew why He wanted me to hear it

3- He instructed me to make it an anthem for this year

4- He reminded me of my being in this spot before

When we left the hotel, the strip center, the ministry house, started rotating

But also, when we began DIT, started observing the Festivals, then Shabbat

5- He connected these lyrics to my upcoming decisions

I knew what I had to do to initiate this journey & get some folk out of Egypt

6- He stressed the import of them to our new journey

I now knew that some would never achieve their destiny without this decision

The Song Was – Burn the Ships

1- It connected the map & new life to our new journey

2- It connected our new journey to our commission It is fully revealed & sealed

We were called and created to be Leaders & Developers of the Remnant

3- It connected our commission to our new crossroad

We have to fully embrace who we are and reject who we aren't

We have never been a typical church and never will be

We are eiyons, which is why we cannot look to them as examples

4- It connected our new crossroad to needed changes

These changes are our next-to-last transformation before Jacob's Trouble

5- It answered my question as to "when"

My question has always been, "how will I know when it's time?"

The Spirit has always told me, you will know when it's time - It's time

Fulfilling Our Commission Requires



1- There be a permanent change to our Shabbat worship

We will no longer meet corporately at Anais for Shabbat worship

This will continue to be done at homes and via streaming

We will only physically congregate

On Festivals, New Moon's, Special Events & Special Outings

The Spirit has prophesied this day would come several years ago

So, don't think this is just our response to the Corona Virus

2- We have more types of fellowship

We will be holding Shabbat Services in different locations besides the home

There will be more Special Member Services that will be open to the public

3- We know His intent for our services

Members are to invite others to worship with them or via streaming & should

Discuss NM & Festival lessons w/ interested parties/refer them to minister

4- We must be aware of our responsibilities

Now is the time to extend invitations via fellowship

We will begin to reincorporate Facebook into our announcing packages

5- We will have 4 concurrent Regionals monthly, all open to the universal Body

1st Type - Way we are currently doing 2nd Type - An in-depth bible study

3rd Type - Real Talk for those 18-25 4th Type - Special topics or books

Each Regional Group will have a different teacher and format

Members & guests can choose the Regional group they wish to attend

And no one has to indefinitely commit - They can't jump back & forth

between groups that day

6- We resume in person and Zoom Small Group Meetings (gender, After-Glow)

Need for Professionalism and Proficiency



1- Have Fixed Start Times

**Start time for evening New Moon's & Festivals is 7:00 pm
Everything else 7:30 pm**

2- Know Parental Responsibilities

Kids are to be fed and ready for class; no eating or playing

3- Know Care Group Responsibilities

CG's will select monthly Shabbat Readers from those present at New Moon

4- Know Teacher Responsibilities

Lessons must be pre-approved 24 hrs before being taught (live or streaming)

5- Have a Different Closing Protocol

Ministers will dismiss svc after corporate prayer and thank guests & visitors

6- Have Prayer and Fellowship Rooms

Prayer rooms (M/W) & fellowship rooms (adults/kids) will open after service
