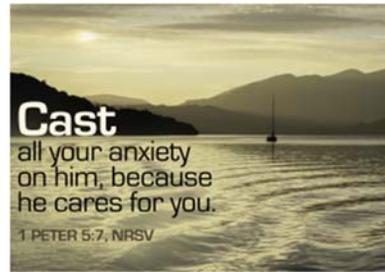

Responsive Scripture Reading



Phil 4:4-9

For what I received from the Lord is just what I passed on to you — that the Lord Yeshua, on the night he was betrayed, took bread;

Cong And after he had made the b'rakhah he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this as a memorial to me"

likewise also the cup after the meal, saying, "This cup is the New Covenant effected by my blood; do this, as often as you drink it, as a memorial to me."

Cong For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord, until he comes.

Therefore, whoever eats the Lord's bread or drinks the Lord's cup in an unworthy manner will be guilty of desecrating the body and blood of the Lord! So let a person examine himself first, and then he may eat of the bread and drink from the cup;

Cong For a person who eats and drinks without recognizing the body eats and drinks judgment upon himself.

This is why many among you are weak and sick, and some have died! If we would examine ourselves, we would not come under judgment.

Cong But when we are judged by the Lord, we are being disciplined, so that we will not be condemned along with the world.

So then, my brothers, when you gather together to eat, wait for one another.

Cong If someone is hungry, he should eat at home, so that when you meet together it will not result in judgment.

4 Rejoice in union with the Lord always! I will say it again: rejoice! 5 Let everyone see how reasonable and gentle you are. The Lord is near! 6 Don't worry about anything; on the contrary, make your requests known to God by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving. 7 Then God's shalom, passing all understanding, will keep your hearts and minds safe in union with the Messiah Yeshua.

8 In conclusion, brothers, focus your thoughts on what is true, noble, righteous, pure, lovable or admirable, on some virtue or on something praiseworthy. 9 Keep doing what you have learned and received from me, what you have heard and seen me doing; then the God who gives shalom will be with you.
