Yom Kippur 5781

Review - For those new to the faith or unfamiliar with the Father's festivals

Festivals are 7 divinely appointed "set apart" times aka [mo'eds] that belong to Yahweh

Where He gathers His children to worship Him, fellowship with brethren & receive instruction

Lev 23:1-3 "Adonai said to Moshe, 2 "Tell the people of Isra'el: 'The designated times of Adonai which you are to proclaim as holy convocations are my designated times. 3 "Work is to be done on six days; but the seventh day is a Shabbat of complete rest, a holy convocation; you are not to do any kind of work; it is a Shabbat for Adonai, even in your homes." CJB

He is the source; He sets the times; He gives them meaning and He is their ultimate Object

Spring "set-apart" festivals were all fulfilled by Yeshua at His first coming

Passover (Pesach), Unleavened Bread (Hag HaMatzah), First Fruits (Hag Bikkurim)

Pentecost (Shavu'ot)

Fall "set-apart" festivals reveal redemptive acts Yeshua will perform when He returns

Trumpets (Yom Teruah), Atonement (Yom Kippur), Tabernacles (Sukkot)

Why are we here today at Yom Kippur? - We are here to

_____ the Father for granting us Atonement via the affliction of His Son

Lev 16:29-30 "It is to be a permanent regulation for you that on the tenth day of the seventh month you are to deny yourselves and not do any kind of work, both the citizen and the foreigner living with you. 30 For on this day, atonement will be made for you to purify you; you will be clean before Adonai from all your sins." CJB

What happens when we don't observe Yom Kippur?

We digress spiritually because we grow in sin rather than in grace

_____ our souls as a reminder of what Yeshua endured to provide us this atonement

Yeshua didn't have an easy time suffering because He was the Son of God; neither will we

Yeshua endured the suffering because He was the Son of Man & so will we this 1 day

Why is Yom Kippur important to 2nd Covenant believers?

Yom Kippur _____ explain what Yeshua actually did and why He is the ONLY way

He is the cornerstone in the Father's house - There are no others

Others can only be at best, His emissary, prophet, proclaimer, shepherd, etc.

Acts 4:11-12 "This Yeshua is the stone rejected by you builders which has become the cornerstone. 12 There is salvation in no one else! For there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by whom we must be saved!" CJB

Notes

Yom Kippur _____ explain the basis for Yeshua's resurrection as a human being

He is mankind's ONLY redeemer because only He could offer a sinless soul as a sacrifice

2 Cor 5:21 "God made this sinless man be a sin offering on our behalf, so that in union with him we might fully share in God's righteousness." CJB

_____ explain the reason for our being here today

I am here to seek forgiveness and request mercy to receive the Father's grace

Heb 4:16 "Therefore, let us confidently approach the throne from which God gives grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace in our time of need." CJB

1st Covenant - Believers hoped to be forgiven, purified and cleansed on this Day

2nd Covenant - Believers know we can be forgiven, purified and cleansed today

Yom Kippur is the holiest day of the year, even more holy than Pesach or what some call Easter

It's the Day in heaven (pre-created earth) when the Plan of Salvation was put into effect

Ps 2:7-8 "I will proclaim the decree: Adonai said to me, 'You are my son; today I became your father. 8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance; the whole wide world will be your possession.'"

Lesson

Yom Kippur _____ past crucifixion work Yeshua did as our High Priest mediator

Heb 9:15-17 "It is because of this death that he is mediator of a new covenant [or will]. Because a death has occurred which sets people free from the transgressions committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promised eternal inheritance. 16 For where there is a will, there must necessarily be produced evidence of its maker's death, 17 since a will goes into effect only upon death; it never has force while its maker is still alive." CJB

The job of the high priest was to take care of "all things pertaining to God"

Meaning he was responsible for all things in the service of God on behalf of the people

Yom Kippur _____ work Yeshua did as a High Priest mediator to set sinful men free

1 - Appreciating this memorial work requires we understand this sacrificial reality

The pre-creation Plan of Salvation demanded the priest's work foreshadow Yeshua's work

Heb 10:1 "For the Torah has in it a shadow of the good things to come, but not the actual manifestation of the originals. Therefore, it can never, by means of the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, bring to the goal those who approach the Holy Place to offer them." CJB

As the earthly high priest had to intercede regularly for the people - So does Yeshua

Heb 7:24-25 "But because he lives forever, his position as cohen does not pass on to someone else; 25 and consequently, he is totally able to deliver those who approach God through him; since he is alive forever and thus forever able to intercede on their behalf." CJB

Notes

Yeshua still intercedes on our behalf because we still deliberately sin sometimes

His past sacrificial work does not atone for sin committed after we know the truth

Heb 10:26-27 “For if we deliberately continue to sin after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, 27 but only the terrifying prospect of Judgment, of raging fire that will consume the enemies.” CJB

But our confession does allow Him to atone for our intentional sin (Satan hates this)

1 John 1:9 “If we acknowledge our sins, then, since he is trustworthy and just, he will forgive them and purify us from all wrongdoing.” CJB

Notes

2- Appreciating this memorial work requires we change how we view His sacrificial death

Rev 13:8 “Everyone living on earth will worship it except those whose names are written in the Book of Life belonging to the Lamb slaughtered before the world was founded.” CJB

Fantasy - Yeshua died before the foundation; this contradicts 2 vital _____ statements

Scripture says Yeshua experienced death only “once” (which was around 33 AD)

Rom 6:10 “For his death was a unique event that need not be repeated; but his life, he keeps on living for God” CJB

Scripture also says Yeshua was offered only “once” as a propitiation for our sins

Heb 9:28 “So also the Messiah, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin, but to deliver those who are eagerly waiting for him.” CJB

Reality - Yeshua was _____ to die for our sins before world’s foundation

This ordination was so certain, it was spoken of then as if it had already occurred

In other words, the Father called into existence what was nonexistent at the time

Rom 4:17 “This accords with the Tanakh, where it says, “I have appointed you to be a father to many nations.” Avraham is our father in God’s sight because he trusted God as the one who gives life to the dead and calls nonexistent things into existence.” CJB

Fantasy - I have the power to call nonexistent things into existence

Reality - I trust in and agree with the One who can call things into existence

We were ordained at that same time to be the Father’s sons “without defect”

Eph 1:4-6 “In the Messiah he chose us in love before the creation of the universe to be holy and without defect in his presence. 5 He determined in advance that through Yeshua the Messiah we would be his sons – in keeping with his pleasure and purpose – 6 so that we would bring him praise commensurate with the glory of the grace he gave us through the Beloved One.” CJB

Notes

We do not actually become “without defect” until we receive our final _____

2 Cor 5:1 “We know that when the tent which houses us here on earth is torn down, we have a permanent building from God, a building not made by human hands, to house us in heaven.” CJB

3 - Appreciating this memorial work requires we change how we view the results of His death

The Father no longer uses earthly mediators this way - All men access Him now via His son

People can be intercessors and examples, but not mediators

1 Tim 2:5-6 “For God is one; and there is but one Mediator between God and humanity, Yeshua the Messiah, himself human, 6 who gave himself as a ransom on behalf of all, thus providing testimony to God’s purpose at just the right time.” CJB

YK memorializes what He does as a Melchizedek Priest King (whose basis is authority not lineage)

Heb 7:15-17 “It becomes even clearer if a “different kind of cohen,” one like Malki-Tzedek, arises, 16 one who became a cohen not by virtue of a rule in the Torah concerning physical descent, but by virtue of the power of an indestructible life. 17 For it is stated, “You are a cohen FOREVER, to be compared with Malki-Tzedek.”

This is why Saul was rejected - Only a king after this order could receive and offer sacrifices

1 Sam 13:11-13 “Sh’mu’el said, “What have you done?” Sha’ul answered, “I saw that the army was drifting away from me, that you hadn’t come during the time appointed and that the P’lishtim had assembled at Mikhmas. 12 I said, ‘Now the P’lishtim will fall on me at Gilgal, and I haven’t asked the favor of Adonai,’ so I forced myself and offered the burnt offering.” 13 Sh’mu’el said to Sha’ul, “You did a foolish thing. You didn’t observe the mitzvah of Adonai, which he gave you. If you had, Adonai would have set up your kingship over Isra’el forever” CJB

Conclusion

What role does Yom Kippur play in the End Times? - Since Yeshua is King, Priest & Great Prophet

When He returns physically to earth, all creation will bow before Him that Day

Phil 2:9-11 “Therefore God raised him to the highest place and gave him the name above every name; 10 that in honor of the name given Yeshua, every knee will bow — in heaven, on earth and under the earth — 11 and every tongue will acknowledge that Yeshua the Messiah is Adonai — to the glory of God the Father.” CJB

Believers will bow before Yeshua out of reverence; unbelievers out of submission

What role does Yom Kippur play in my End Times? - Since Yeshua is my King, Priest & Prophet
