## **General Requirements For All Classes**

### **Class Expectations**

- 1- Class members are expected to be committed to excellence in all aspects of the class to facilitate their spiritual learning experience. This includes being on time, doing their respective assignments at the proper time, and individually engaging in classroom discussions.
- 2- Class members are expected to strive for excellence in their personal Kingdom walk. They are also to endeavor to display Yeshua's character in and out of class, which includes being loving and patient towards other class members at all times.

### **Class Requirements**

- 1- No class member is permitted to share personal information heard in this class to anyone outside this class. All class members are expected to adhere to the respective prohibitions listed in the WOC International Privacy and Confidentiality Agreements. This means, they are not to disclose class conversations with their spouses, relatives or others for any reason. No one will be permitted to remain in this class without WOC International having a signed copy of both of these agreements on file.
- 2- All class room struggles must be communicated with the current teacher, not a former teacher, another class member, or a member of WOC International. Violations of this requirement will result in immediate dismissal from the class.
- 3- Class members are expected to follow all of WOC International's Zoom protocols; give their real first name; and keep the camera turned on at all times during class (no photo backgrounds). No non-class member is permitted to be in proximity to a class member while class is in session, to where that individual can see and hear what is being said.
- 4- Class members are not permitted to record class sessions for any reason. Anyone who records a session will be immediately dismissed from the class without further delay and subject to possible legal action.
- 5- Continuance in this class is at the discretion of the teacher and WOCI International. If a class member is deemed disorderly, corrective measures on the part of the teacher will be attempted first. If this proves to be unsuccessful or if a specific class member becomes disruptive: they will be dismissed from the class and not permitted to continue.

## WOCI Requirements

- 1- All teachers are expected to maintain confidentiality regarding private discussions among class members; except when it concerns legal issues WOC International is bound by law to disclose. If something of a legal nature like this occurs, the teacher will notify the class member this legal issue concerns that it is being referred to an executive of WOC International. All communication thereafter will involve that class member and that specific executive to ensure WOC International is in compliance with the law.
- 2- Information discussed in this class concerns the application of Scripture for spiritual edification. Nothing said in it by a teacher or a member should be taken, suggested or construed as the appropriate legal, marital, psychological, financial, etc. advice a class member should take for their particular situation or circumstance.
- 3- Classes are free of charge. No teacher at WOC International is permitted to charge or receive money for teaching a class, nor are they permitted to provide private counseling of any type (free or paid). If a class member insists on donating money, it must be given directly to WOC International via mail (PO Box 1714 Alief, Texas 77411) or our website (<https://www.woc-intl.org/giving-2/>). If this happens, it will be placed into the General Operating Account to avoid any possible financial impropriety or conflict of interest.
