Review - For those new to the faith or unfamiliar with the biblical concept of New Moon

2nd Month (Iyar), 3rd (Sivan), 4th (Tammuz), 5th (Av), 6th (Elul) / 8th Month (Bul)

What have we covered thus far the Spirit uses to direct us in our duties on the road to destiny?

9th Month (Kislev) - True servants provide selfless service

10th Month (Tevet) - Selfless service generates benevolent works

Introduction

Tevet is the first month of Winter (Tevet, Shevat, Adar) and connects to the tribe of Dan

It's also the first month in the year where the days begin to lengthen on the way to Spring

Tevet shares a root with the Hebrew word [tov], which means "good"

Tevet is when the Spirit exposes truths in the midst of Tevet's corporate persecution that

Reveal His _____ good to those that are seeking via a redefinition of "what's good"

Give _____ comfort to those in the Valley via a redefinition of "the mountain"

Important facts to focus on concerning the 10th month of Tevet this year

Always starts with the last days of Hanukkah and memorializes a cruel oppression of the faithful

Also was the time the Judeans sought to kill Yeshua for claiming to be the Son of God

John 10:22, 31-33 "Then came Hanukkah in Yerushalayim. It was winter ... 31 Once again the Judeans picked up rocks in order to stone him. 32 Yeshua answered them, "You have seen me do many good deeds that reflect the Father's power; for which one of these deeds are you stoning me?" 33 The Judeans replied, "We are not stoning you for any good deed, but for blasphemy – because you, who are only a man, are making yourself out to be God [Hebrew: Elohim]." CJB

Important facts to focus on concerning Dan (the son of Jacob) this year

Name "Dan" translates as "judge", "to minister judgment", and "to plead a cause"

Reality - Yahweh had prophetically appointed Dan to be a judge in Israel

Which meant, he was divinely given an _____ rule with the sons of Leah & Rachel

Gen 49:16 "Dan will judge his people as one of the tribes of Isra'el" CJB

Yet he still felt like an outcast with his older brothers as Jacob's 5th son (1st by Bilhah)

So, rather than be happy with his appointment (equal rule), he chose an _____ life

One that prophetically compared him to a viper

Gen 49:17 "Dan will be a viper on the road, a horned snake in the path that bites the horse's heels so its rider falls off backward." CJB

Notes

The problem was, he felt this same way about Joseph as well, even though he was born after him

Gen 37:19-20 “They said to each other, “Look, this dreamer is coming! 20 So come now, let’s kill him and throw him into one of these water cisterns here. Then we’ll say some wild animal devoured him. We’ll see then what becomes of his dreams!”

Why did Jacob’s other sons (especially the hand maiden ones) want to murder Joseph?

Gen 37:2 “Here is the history of Ya’akov. When Yosef was seventeen years old he used to pasture the flock with his brothers, even though he was still a boy. Once when he was with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father’s wives, he brought a bad report about them to their father.” CJB

We don’t know exactly what the hand maiden sons had done, but we do know this

It was _____ enough (Hebrew [Ra] means evil, distress) for Joseph to tell Jacob

Notes

Important facts to focus on concerning Dan (the tribe) this year

Dan was 2nd largest of the 4 tribal encampments (outnumbered Manasseh 2 to 1 & Ephraim 3 to 2)

They stationed on the N side and were to move last when it came time to march

Jewish history confirms some of the Danites choosing to remain in Egypt and not go to Canaan

It also confirmed many of them marrying Egyptians while they were in Egypt

Oholi’av was a Danite who honorably co-constructed some of Israel’s most holiest objects

Ex 31:6 “I have also appointed as his assistant Oholi’av the son of Achisamakh, of the tribe of Dan. Moreover, I have endowed all the craftsmen with the wisdom to make everything I have ordered you”

But Scripture records a few Danites who were spiritually dishonorable in their behavior

An unnamed mixed Danite blasphemed Yahweh’s Name in a fight and died an ignoble death

Lev 24:10-11 “There was a man who was the son of a woman of Isra’el and an Egyptian father. He went out among the people of Isra’el, and this son of a woman of Isra’el had a fight in the camp with a man of Isra’el, 11 in the course of which the son of the woman of Isra’el uttered the Name [Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh] in a curse. So they brought him to Moshe. (His mother’s name was Shlomit the daughter of Dibri, of the tribe of Dan.)” CJB

Samson (Israel’s 14th unholy Danite judge) died an unnecessary ignoble death

The Anti-Messiah (an unholy Danite) will blaspheme the Name and die an ignoble death

Rev 19:20 “But the beast was taken captive, and with it the false prophet who, in its presence, had done the miracles which he had used to deceive those who had received the mark of the beast and those who had worshipped his image. The beast and the false prophet were both thrown alive into the lake of fire that burns with sulfur.” CJB

Notes

What are benevolent works and how do they pertain to this season's Birth Pains service?

Benevolent works - Spirit inspired acts that fulfill divine purposes according to times & seasons

He uses _____ to reveal His general Will (Fests) & _____ for specific Will (NM's)

Gal 5:16-17 "What I am saying is this: run your lives by the Spirit. Then you will not do what your old nature wants. 17 For the old nature wants what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit wants what is contrary to the old nature. These oppose each other, so that you find yourselves unable to carry out your good intentions." CJB

Self-initiated works - Fleshly acts that fulfill human purposes in self-determined times & seasons

John 3:6 "What is born from the flesh is flesh, and what is born from the Spirit is spirit." CJB

Notes

How do benevolent works pertain to our lesson about Dan and his appointed service?

Because the Danites judged Israel to be too weak to help & the Philistines too strong to conquer

They inspired their brethren to _____ a human King rule over and FIGHT for them

1 Sam 8:19-20 "However, the people refused to listen to what Sh'mu'el told them, and they said, "No! We want a king over us, 20 so that we can be like all the nations, with our king to judge us, lead us and fight our battles." CJB

If the Danites had remained true to their appointment in their territory and commission, their ...

_____ would have made them flourish as they benevolently served in their spot

They wouldn't have chosen to perform non-benevolent works outside their PCF's nor

Nor unlawfully occupy sections of Naphtali & Manasseh's appointed territory

Josh 19:47 "The territory of the descendants of Dan was too small for them, so the descendants of Dan went up and fought against Leshem, captured it, defeated it by the sword, took possession of it and lived there, calling Leshem "Dan" after Dan their ancestor."

_____ would have shielded them from an apostate Levite and an apostate religion

And becoming a cult center for idolatrous worship, plunging Israel into a state of idolatry

Judg 18:16-20 "The 600 soldiers from Dan stayed at the gate, 17 while the five who had spied out the land went in and took the idol overlaid with silver, the vest and the household gods. The cohen had stayed with the 600 soldiers by the gate. 18 But when they went into Mikhah's house and took the silver-covered image, the vest and the household gods, the cohen asked them, "What are you doing?" 19 They replied, "Be quiet, keep your mouth shut, and come with us. Be a father and a cohen for us. Which is better? To be a cohen in the house of one man or to be cohen to a whole tribe and family in Isra'el?" 20 This made the cohen feel very good; so he took the ritual vest, the household gods and the image and went off with the people." CJB

Notes

Because the Danites forsook their appointment & anointing & chose to brazenly erect high places

Their lineage was terminated for violating earlier agreed upon Deuteronomic _____

Deut 29:18-20 “If there is such a person, when he hears the words of this curse, he will bless himself secretly, saying to himself, ‘I will be all right, even though I will stubbornly keep doing whatever I feel like doing; so that I, although “dry,” [sinful,] will be added to the “watered” [righteous].’ 19(20) But Adonai will not forgive him. Rather, the anger and jealousy of Adonai will blaze up against that person. Every curse written in this book will be upon him. Adonai will blot out his name from under heaven. 20(21) Adonai will single him out from all the tribes of Isra’el to experience what is bad in all the curses of the covenant written in this book of the Torah.” CJB

As such, indulgence in idolatry led to them individually being blotted out

Amos 8:11 “Those who swear by the sin of Shomron, who say, ‘As your god, Dan, lives,’ and, ‘As the way of Be’er-Sheva lives’ – they will fall and never get up again.” CJB

And the tribe’s name being permanently removed from the _____ roster

Rev 7:4-8 “I heard how many were sealed – 144,000 from every tribe of the people of Isra’el: 5 From the tribe of Y’hudah 12,000 were sealed, from the tribe of Re’uven 12,000, from the tribe of Gad 12,000, 6 from the tribe of Asher 12,000, from the tribe of Naftali 12,000, from the tribe of M’nasheh 12,000, 7 from the tribe of Shim’on 12,000, from the tribe of Levi 12,000, from the tribe of Yissakhar 12,000, 8 from the tribe of Z’vulun 12,000, from the tribe of Yosef 12,000, from the tribe of Binyamin 12,000.” CJB

Yahweh stationed the Danites where all of Israel could have access to judgment

But they chose to focus on what the other tribes didn’t do for them, which

Led to them being assimilated when they separated and tried to protect themselves

The Spirit uses BW to provide _____ to selfless servants via the work of selfless others

Rom 15:2-3 “Each of us should please his neighbor and act for his good, thus building him up. 3 For even the Messiah did not please himself; rather, as the Tanakh says, ‘The insults of those insulting you fell on me.’” CJB

Why are benevolent works important to the planting of His seed beginning this Tevet?

The Spirit is using BW this month to passively implant the seeds for long-term change
