Introduction - 2nd Month of Spring, 8th month of civil year & 2nd month of ecclesiastical year Iyar or Ziv, is an ordained month of _____ (i.e. revelation to understand times & secrets)

1 Chron 12:22 "Of the descendants of Yissakhar, men who understood the times and knew what Isra'el ought to do, there were 200 leaders, and all their kinsmen were under their command." CJB

What is this verse revealing about Issachar? - They were a scholarly and prophetic tribe

They were in alignment with Yahweh's _____ & in sync with His _____

Note - Many members of the Sanhedren came from the tribe of Issachar

What does this passage reveal about the Community position of prophets in general?

They were never tribal leaders, they were always advisors to the leaders (e.g. Nathan)

Judah - The "apostolic leadership" tribe who led the nation and always march first

Issachar - The "Torah" tribe who bore the burden for victory marched second

Zebulun - The "wealth tribe" who was responsible for the provision marched third

Iyar is a month of _____ - A time of introspection for the sake of self-improvement

Iyar 14 was a 2nd Passover to those who missed the first one for legitimate reasons

Num 9:9-12 "Adonai said to Moshe, 10 "Tell the people of Isra'el, 'If any of you now or in future generations is unclean because of a corpse, or if he is on a trip abroad, nevertheless he is to observe Pesach. 11 But he will observe it in the second month on the fourteenth day at dusk. They are to eat it with matzah and maror, 12 they are to leave none of it until morning, and they are not to break any of its bones – they are to observe it according to all the regulations of Pesach. " CJB

Iyar is a month of _____ - Is the only month the Omer is counted each day of the month

Lev 23:15-17 “From the day after the day of rest – that is, from the day you bring the sheaf for waving – you are to count seven full weeks, 16 until the day after the seventh week; you are to count fifty days; and then you are to present a new grain offering to Adonai. 17 You must bring bread from your homes for waving – two loaves made with one gallon of fine flour, baked with leaven – as firstfruits for Adonai.” CJB

Iyar is a month of _____ - Before they reached Mt Sinai on Shavuot to finalize the covenant

Most Israelites disbelieved and as such, failed several tests to grow their trust - They ...

Failed the Red Sea Test (Ex 15) - They panicked when they initially couldn't cross over

Failed the Marah Test (Ex 15) - They found an oasis, but complained the water was bitter

Failed the wilderness of Sin Test (Ex 16) - They complained the provisions were too small

Failed the Rephidim Test (Exodus 17)- They complained there was no water

What happens when we believe? - We welcome the testing to receive His Shavu'ot promise

We keep moving forward without murmuring & complaining because we trust Yahweh

We trust that He will be good to us & that He wants us to make it to His mountain

Iyar's acronym is a name of _____ - Was in Iyar Yahweh first revealed Himself as Healer

Ex 15:26 “He said, “If you will listen intently to the voice of Adonai your God, do what he considers right, pay attention to his mitzvot and observe his laws, I will not afflict you with any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians; because I am Adonai your healer.” CJB

Iyar is an acronym of Aleph, Yud, Yud, Resh or Ani Hashem Rofecha or Ani Yahweh Rophe

Iyar is a month of _____ - Natural Israel transitioned from Egypt to Sinai to gain a ...

New relationship with Yahweh as their Covenant Maker

Yahweh was Israel's Husband, not just Deliverer, and the nation was Yahweh's wife

New revelation in the Wilderness about Yahweh and hidden secrets of His covenant

In Ex 16:12, He revealed Himself to His wife as Yahweh _____, Lord their Provider

When He sent quail in the evening and rained down Manna in the morning

In Ex 16:26, He revealed Himself to His wife as Lord of the _____

When He taught them to rest and trust that He would provide whatever they needed

In Ex 17:14-15, He revealed Himself to His wife as Yahweh _____, the Lord their Banner

When they were victorious in battle via supernatural means against the Amalekites

Iyar is also a time of transition for spiritual Israel, from Babylon to New Jerusalem

To gain a new revelation about Yeshua & His covenant secrets to His bride in this world

2 Important facts about the 2nd month of Iyar

When we are in a time of testing, we should never forget there's a purpose for it: fix _____

And that Yahweh has a finite limit for all testing - No one is tested constantly

If Satan didn't test Yeshua all of the time, neither is he testing you most of the time

Every Iyar, the Father wants to reveal deeper _____ about the covenant we have in Yeshua

Which is why as spiritual Israel, we must reconfirm our covenant in the 1st Month every year

So that He can take us to a whole new level of reality every year in the 3rd Month (Sivan)

Important facts to know about Issachar (the son of Jacob)

1 - He was the 5th son of Jacob via Leah (9th son overall); born a while after her 4 other children

Long enough afterwards that she arranged to have more children with Jacob through Zilpah

2 - Issachar's symbol was that of a donkey, which was a reflection of

Issachar's _____ - Able to simultaneously bear the heavy burdens of others and himself

Gen 49:14-15 "Yissakhar is a strong donkey lying down in the sheep sheds. 15 On seeing how good is settled life and how pleasant the country, he will bend his back to the burden, and submit to forced labor." CJB

Issachar's _____ - Be a burden bearer that didn't share someone's business with others

3 - Issachar was conceived on a night Leah "hired" Jacob from Rachel for the evening

In exchange for some roots Rachel _____ would enhance her fertility to have children

Gen 30:16-18 "When Ya'akov came in from the field in the evening, Le'ah went out to meet him and said, "You have to come and sleep with me, because I've hired you with my son's mandrakes." So Ya'akov slept with her that night. 17 God listened to Le'ah, and she conceived and bore Ya'akov a fifth son. 18 Le'ah said, "God has given me my hire, because I gave my slave-girl to my husband." So she called him Yissakhar [hire, reward]." CJB

Important facts to know about Issachar (the tribe of Israel)

Issachar camped on the E side with Judah & Zebulun and were part of the 1st group to march

Deut 33:18-19 "Of Z'vulun he said: "Rejoice, Z'vulun, as you go forth, and you, Yissakhar, in your tents. 19 They will summon peoples to the mountain and there offer righteous sacrifices; for they will draw from the abundance of the seas and from the hidden treasures of the sand." CJB

Issachar was also 1 of the 6 tribes to stand on Mt Ebal and pronounce blessings (Deut 27:11-12)
