RESPONSIVE SCRIPTURE



LAM 3:19-26

And may God, the source of encouragement and patience, give you the same attitude among yourselves as the Messiah Yeshua had,

CONG so that with one accord and with one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.

So welcome each other, just as the Messiah has welcomed you into God's glory. 8 For I say that the Messiah became a servant of the Jewish people

CONG in order to show God's truthfulness by making good his promises to the Patriarchs,

and in order to show his mercy by causing the Gentiles to glorify God – as it is written in the Tanakh,

CONG "Because of this I will acknowledge you among the Gentiles and sing praise to your name."

10 And again it says, "Gentiles, rejoice with his people." 11 And again, "Praise Adonai, all Gentiles! Let all peoples praise him!"

CONG And again, Yesha'yahu says, "The root of Yishai will come, he who arises to rule Gentiles; Gentiles will put their hope in him."

May God, the source of hope, fill you completely with joy and shalom as you continue trusting,

CONG So that by the power of the Ruach HaKodesh you may overflow with hope.

19 Remember my utter misery, the worm-wood and the gall. 20 They are always on my mind; this is why I am so depressed.

21 But in my mind I keep returning to something, something that gives me hope – 22 that the grace of Adonai is not exhausted, that his compassion has not ended. 23 [On the contrary,] they are new every morning!

How great your faithfulness! 24 "Adonai is all I have," I say; "therefore I will put my hope in him.

25 Adonai is good to those waiting for him, to those who are seeking him out. 26 It is good to wait patiently for the saving help of Adonai. CJB
