Opening Slide

Lesson - How does the sanctification of Atonement prepare me for Sukkot's Joy?

Its principles & practices cause me to take a spiritual inventory of my person and my walk

So that I see the need to be at home and in harmonious relationship with my Father (at-one)

Observing Atonement (at-one-ment) allays any _____ I am at variance with my Father

It helps me trust Yeshua's holiness satisfactorily fulfilled the Father's justice requirements

When He presented Himself voluntarily as a substitutionary sacrifice on my behalf

2 Cor 5:21 "God made this sinless man be a sin offering on our behalf, so that in union with him we might fully share in God's righteousness." CJB

Observing Atonement fulfills my need for paternal _____ because of personal sin

Micah 7:18-19 "Who is a God like you, pardoning the sin and overlooking the crimes of the remnant of his heritage? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in grace. 19 He will again have compassion on us, he will subdue our iniquities. You will throw all their sins into the depths of the sea."

Merriam-Websters says compassion

Is a sympathetic consciousness of others' distress together with a desire to alleviate it

How does this definition differ from the compassion [raham] spoken of in Micah 7:18-19?

[Raham] is not a consciousness of mankind's distress the Father desires to alleviate

It's a deep love moving to repair the bond sin broke between He and His children

1 Thess 5:23-24 "May the God of shalom make you completely holy – may your entire spirit, soul and body be kept blameless for the coming of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah. 24 The one calling you is faithful, and he will do it." CJB

What truths does His compassion regarding my pardon on Yom Kippur force me to accept?

He _____ to be merciful to me even though I didn't deserve it

Romans 9:15-16 "For to Moshe he says, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will pity whom I pity." 16 Thus it doesn't depend on human desires or efforts, but on God, who has mercy" CJB

His pardon includes a current and future _____ of transgression

Ps 103:12-13 "He has removed our sins from us as far as the east is from the west. 13 Just as a father has compassion on his children, Adonai has compassion on those who fear him." CJB

And this pardon transcends time and Judgment

Jeremiah 50:20 “In those days, at that time,” says Adonai, “Isra’el’s guilt will be sought, but there will be none, and Y’hudah’s sins, but they won’t be found; for I will pardon the remnant I leave.” CJB

Even though I must face the consequences of my sin; they will be removed later

2 Cor 5:10 “For we must all appear before the Messiah’s court of judgment, where everyone will receive the good or bad consequences of what he did while he was in the body.” CJB

His pardon removes my _____ of what will happen when Yeshua returns

Heb 4:13 “Before God, nothing created is hidden, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of him to whom we must render an account.” CJB

And keeps me from _____ when Yeshua does return like the non-believers

Rev 1:7 “Look! He is coming with the clouds! Every eye will see him, including those who pierced him; and all the tribes of the Land will mourn him.” CJB

As a good servant, why will I not mourn at Yeshua’s return?

I sought and granted forgiveness and am doing what He commanded

2 Tim 4:7-8 “I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 All that awaits me now is the crown of righteousness which the Lord, “the Righteous Judge,” will award to me on that Day – and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for him to appear.” CJB

Conclusion - What do I need to take home from today’s preparation?

I am going to celebrate my freedom this Sukkot because I forgave and have been forgiven

Yom Kippur rituals reveal the reality of Yeshua removing my sin as my High Priest, now ...

I rest in the fact my Father is not always _____ with me

Ps 103:9-11 “He will not always accuse, he will not keep his anger forever. 10 He has not treated us as our sins deserve or paid us back for our offenses, 11 because his mercy toward those who fear him is as far above earth as heaven.” CJB

Yeshua’s actual intercessory role as my High Priest reminds me that

No false ideology or feelings of failure can imprison me; He forgave me!

I trust in His _____ of a replacement tent when He returns

Because the tent (i.e. body) I currently occupy is temporary and declining daily

2 Cor 5:2-3 “For in this tent, our earthly body, we groan with desire to have around us the home from heaven that will be ours. 3 With this around us we will not be found naked.” CJB

But something better awaits, my personal eternal sukkah!

Phil 3:20-21 “But we are citizens of heaven, and it is from there that we expect a Deliverer, the Lord Yeshua the Messiah. 21 He will change the bodies we have in this humble state and make them like his glorious body, using the power which enables him to bring everything under his control.” CJB

I conquer _____ trying to make me impatient regarding my status and His return

Rom 8:22-24 “We know that until now, the whole creation has been groaning as with the pains of childbirth; 23 and not only it, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we continue waiting eagerly to be made sons – that is, to have our whole bodies redeemed and set free.” CJB

I am going to celebrate during Sukkot because of who I am ... His!

And I will be obediently doing my Father’s work when Yeshua returns

Titus 2:14 “He gave himself up on our behalf in order to free us from all violation of Torah and purify for himself a people who would be his own, eager to do good.” CJB
