Review - Festivals are 7 divinely appointed "set apart" times aka [mo'edim]

Yahweh gathers us to worship (pray, receive instruction, give) & fellowship with brethren

Festivals belong to Him, not the Jews - He's the source, sets the times, & gives them meaning

Why are Yahweh's 7 festivals relevant to all believers?

They prophesy Yeshua's life, His ministry, His plans, & the role we play in implementing these

Spring "set-apart" festivals typify Yeshua and His 1st Coming as _____

Passover (Pesach) - Typifies Yeshua's work as the Father's sacrificial lamb

Unleavened Bread (Hag HaMatzah) - Typifies Yeshua's life as a sinless human being

First Fruits (Hag Bikkurim) - Typifies Yeshua's resurrection as first born of the brethren

Pentecost (Shavu'ot) - Typifies His empowerment with the Spirit as a human being

Fall "set-apart" festivals typify Yeshua and His 2nd Coming as the Father's _____

Trumpets (Yom Teruah) - Typifies Yeshua's work as Creator & mankind's Redeemer

Atonement (Yom Kippur) - Typifies Yeshua's work as mankind's Intercessor and Judge

Tabernacles (Sukkot) - Typifies Yeshua's work as the King of all creation

They also are one of the Father's extra vehicles to produce spiritual maturity in His children

How does immaturity and not taking spiritual inventory at Yom Kippur hinder our walk?

It makes us miss the connection between Yahweh's Festivals and soul _____

Yom Teruah leads us to repent; Yom Kippur leads us to forgive; Sukkot brings us joy

Why do we have joy at Sukkot? - We did what we were commanded to do

We heeded the call to repent, and we forgave others of their offenses

We considered our ways and we turned from our sin

It makes us miss the connection between Yom Kippur and preparing for _____

Heb 9:27-28 "Just as human beings have to die once, but after this comes judgment, 28 so also the Messiah, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin, but to deliver those who are eagerly waiting for him." CJB

The threat of Judgment accompanied by fear and trembling, only applied to Yom Kippur

Phil 2:12 "So, my dear friends, just as you have always obeyed when I was with you, it is even more important that you obey now when I am away from you: keep working out your deliverance with fear and trembling" CJB

Notes

How does maturity and taking spiritual inventory at Yom Kippur improve our walk?

It reminds us we were created to be at home with the Father in harmonious relations (at-one)

This is what Adam and Eve in Eden (-) and the Prodigal Son coming home (+) was about

Atonement enabling redeemed men to return home without _____

Lesson

Atonement (at-one-ment) is the state of being _____ after having been at variance

Ex 34:6-8 "Adonai passed before him and proclaimed: "YUD-HEH-VAV-HEH!!! Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh [Adonai] is God, merciful and compassionate, slow to anger, rich in grace and truth; 7 showing grace to the thousandth generation, forgiving offenses, crimes and sins; yet not exonerating the guilty, but causing the negative effects of the parents' offenses to be experienced by their children and grandchildren, and even by the third and fourth generations." CJB

The Father purposed Yeshua meet His claims of justice via _____ as a human being

Permitting those formerly "at variance" to put their trust in Him and become one with Him

And share in the redemption He gives as the human Head of redeemed humanity

2 Cor 5:21 "God made this sinless man be a sin offering on our behalf, so that in union with him we might fully share in God's righteousness." CJB

The first Adam lost the title deed to the earth to Satan, but the second Adam regained it

Atonement expresses the concept of removing the _____ of a person utterly out of sight

By a ransom, satisfaction, or substituted victim [e.g. a bull (1 Covenant) Yeshua (2 Covenant)]

In substitution, it's out of sight because it's _____ from the sinful to the innocent

Lev 8:14-15 "Then the young bull for the sin offering was brought, and Aharon and his sons laid their hands on the head of the bull for the sin offering. 15 After it had been slaughtered, Moshe took the blood and put it on the horns of the altar all the way around with his finger, thus purifying the altar. The remaining blood he poured out at the base of the altar and consecrated it, to make atonement for it." CJB

Purpose for atonement in Yom Kippur - Prophecy Yeshua's triumph over sin, death, and Satan

And His making amends for His guilty people with His life as an innocent human being

Because of this symbolism, Israel was never allowed to eat blood under any circumstance

Lev 17:11-12 "For the life of a creature is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for yourselves; for it is the blood that makes atonement because of the life.' 12 This is why I told the people of Isra'el, 'None of you is to eat blood, nor is any foreigner living with you to eat blood.'" CJB

Notes

And His ending the alienation between the Father and men because of sin

From His side, Yeshua's guiltless blood took the place of our forfeited or guilty blood

Rom 3:25-26 "God put Yeshua forward as the kapparah for sin through his faithfulness in respect to his bloody sacrificial death. This vindicated God's righteousness; because, in his forbearance, he had passed over [with neither punishment nor remission] the sins people had committed in the past; 26 and it vindicates his righteousness in the present age by showing that he is righteous himself and is also the one who makes people righteous on the ground of Yeshua's faithfulness." CJB

From our side, our voluntary confession of sin publicly acknowledges that reality

1 John 1:10 "If we claim we have not been sinning, we are making him out to be a liar, and his Word is not in us." CJB

Conclusion - What do I need to take home today?

Reason for Yom Kippur - Sin defiles me and makes me _____ to stand in my Father's presence

And unless atonement is made, my soul would be due the wages of sin (death)

Heb 7:24-25 "But because he lives forever, his position as cohen does not pass on to someone else; 25 and consequently, he is totally able to deliver those who approach God through him; since he is alive forever and thus forever able to intercede on their behalf." CJB

But I shouldn't wait until Yom Kippur to bring my sins to the altar

Earthly atonement began when Yahweh clothed (_____) Adam & Eve in the Garden

Gen 3:21 "Adonai, God, made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them." CJB

Note - This animal was not slain for food, because meat was not eaten until after the Flood

Gen 9:3 "Every moving thing that lives will be food for you; just as I gave you green plants before, so now I give you everything" CJB

It was not slain for clothing; any animal with fleece could've been used to accomplish this

This innocent animal's life was specifically taken to cover humanity's nakedness

This is why Yahweh honored Abel's bloody sacrifice & not Cain's non-bloody sacrifice

Cain knew what to do, Adam had taught him and Abel the need for covering!

Gen 4:6-7 "Adonai said to Kayin, "Why are you angry? Why so downcast? 7 If you are doing what is good, shouldn't you hold your head high? And if you don't do what is good, sin is crouching at the door – it wants you, but you can rule over it." CJB

Notes

Reason for the Fast - Yom Kippur is not just a day to abstain from eating and the usual pleasures

It is a time to stand in _____ fear of my Eternal God

Lev 16:30-31 "For on this day, atonement will be made for you to purify you; you will be clean before Adonai from all your sins. 31 It is a Shabbat of complete rest for you, and you are to deny yourselves." CJB

If I obeyed His instructions on this special day, I could rejoice in Him

It was His idea to unilaterally wipe the slate clean for all of Israel (which includes me)!

It is a time to _____ myself, as my spirit judges my soul for sin, my soul judges my body

1 Cor 11:31- "If we would examine ourselves, we would not come under judgment." CJB

I am not judging myself as a sinner, but a repentant child who strayed from the path

And needs his Father's grace to restore his joy for the ignorant commission of sin

And His mercy for the willful commission of sin

I am reminding myself what Yeshua endured to provide me this atonement

Time to begin this Fast and _____ His mercy and grace

Ps 32:1 "(1) How blessed are those whose offense is forgiven, those whose sin is covered!" CJB
