## CONGREGATION READINGS

## ISAIAH 53

**HOUSEHOLD SERVANTS, SUBMIT YOURSELVES TO YOUR MASTERS, SHOWING THEM FULL RESPECT — AND NOT ONLY THOSE WHO ARE KIND AND CONSIDERATE, BUT ALSO THOSE WHO ARE HARSH. 19 FOR IT IS A GRACE WHEN SOMEONE,**

**CONG** BECAUSE HE IS MINDFUL OF GOD, BEARS UP UNDER THE PAIN OF UNDESERVED PUNISHMENT.

**FOR WHAT CREDIT IS THERE IN BEARING UP UNDER A BEATING YOU DESERVE FOR DOING SOMETHING WRONG?**

**CONG** BUT IF YOU BEAR UP UNDER PUNISHMENT, EVEN THOUGH YOU HAVE DONE WHAT IS RIGHT, GOD LOOKS ON IT WITH FAVOR.

**INDEED, THIS IS WHAT YOU WERE CALLED TO; BECAUSE THE MESSIAH TOO SUFFERED, ON YOUR BEHALF, LEAVING AN EXAMPLE SO THAT YOU SHOULD FOLLOW IN HIS STEPS.**

**CONG** “HE COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND ON HIS LIPS.”

**WHEN HE WAS INSULTED, HE DIDN'T RETALIATE WITH INSULTS; WHEN HE SUFFERED, HE DIDN'T THREATEN, BUT HANDED THEM OVER TO HIM WHO JUDGES JUSTLY.**

**CONG** HE HIMSELF BORE OUR SINS IN HIS BODY ON THE STAKE,

**FOR YOU USED TO BE LIKE SHEEP GONE ASTRAY**

**CONG** BUT NOW YOU HAVE TURNED TO THE SHEPHERD, WHO WATCHES OVER YOU.

WHO BELIEVES OUR REPORT? TO WHOM IS THE ARM OF ADONAI REVEALED? 2 FOR BEFORE HIM HE GREW UP LIKE A YOUNG PLANT, LIKE A ROOT OUT OF DRY GROUND. HE WAS NOT WELL-FORMED OR ESPECIALLY HANDSOME; WE SAW HIM, BUT HIS APPEARANCE DID NOT ATTRACT US.

3 PEOPLE DESPISED AND AVOIDED HIM, A MAN OF PAINS, WELL ACQUAINTED WITH ILLNESS. LIKE SOMEONE FROM WHOM PEOPLE TURN THEIR FACES, HE WAS DESPISED; WE DID NOT VALUE HIM. 4 IN FACT, IT WAS OUR DISEASES HE BORE, OUR PAINS FROM WHICH HE SUFFERED; YET WE REGARDED HIM AS PUNISHED, STRICKEN AND AFFLICTED BY GOD.

5 BUT HE WAS WOUNDED BECAUSE OF OUR CRIMES, CRUSHED BECAUSE OF OUR SINS; THE DISCIPLINING THAT MAKES US WHOLE FELL ON HIM, AND BY HIS BRUISES WE ARE HEALED. 6 WE ALL, LIKE SHEEP, WENT ASTRAY; WE TURNED, EACH ONE, TO HIS OWN WAY; YET ADONAI LAID ON HIM THE GUILT OF ALL OF US.

7 THOUGH MISTREATED, HE WAS SUBMISSIVE — HE DID NOT OPEN HIS MOUTH. LIKE A LAMB LED TO BE SLAUGHTERED, LIKE A SHEEP SILENT BEFORE ITS SHEARERS.” CJB
